



## 2011 South East Asian Games Selection

Waterskiing (Slalom, Trick & Jump) & Wakeboarding will be included in the 2011 South East Asian (SEA) Games to be held in Palembang, Indonesia from 11<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2011.

Medal Sports:-

\*Individual

1. Men's & Women's Slalom
2. Men's & Women's Trick
3. Men's & Women's Jump
4. Men's & Women's Wakeboard

\*\*Team

1. Wakeboard Team Overall

*\* each country will only be permitted to enter two (2) athletes per individual medal sport*

*\*\* each country will only be permitted to enter a team comprising maximum three (3) male athletes & maximum three (3) female athletes*

The Singapore Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (SWWF) will nominate athletes to the Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) to consider for final SEA Games selection.

The SWWF will hold a selection trial as follows to shortlist athletes for nomination:-

Date: Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> May 2011  
Venue: To Be Advised  
Time: 5:00 to 7:00 pm

### Criteria To Attend Selection Trial (as per SNOC Selection criteria)

1. Athletes who are Singapore Citizens.
2. Waterski athletes who achieve minimum 3<sup>rd</sup> place South East Asian ranking at one of the following events:-
  - Singapore Waterski Championships (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> May 2011) – Singapore
  - Putrajaya Waterski & Wakeboard Cup (28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> May 2011) – Putrajaya, Malaysia
3. Wakeboard athletes who achieve at least a 3<sup>rd</sup> placing amongst athletes in South East Asia at the Putrajaya Waterski & Wakeboard Cup (28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> May 2011) – Putrajaya, Malaysia
4. Athletes who miss the qualifying standard marginally at the above events, but show potential to equal or surpass it in time for the Games.

## Other Considerations

In addition to the above selection criteria, the following “qualities” of the athletes will be taken into consideration:

- Attitude and behavior;
- Current skill level and fitness;
- Level of commitment and attendance;
- Potential for future development;
- Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with team mates

## Extenuating Circumstances

In consideration of the performance and “qualities” of athletes, the selectors may at their discretion give consideration to extenuating circumstances. For this purpose, extenuating circumstances” mean an inability of the athlete to compete in and/or attend event arising from:

- Injury or illness;
- Equipment failure;
- Travel delays;
- Bereavement;
- Such other circumstances considered relevant by the selectors

Athletes who meet the above criteria and wish to attend the selection trials are to inform the SWWF of their intention to attend the team trials by latest 30<sup>th</sup> May 2011, 12:00 pm.
